Holes 10 thru 18



Most difficult driving hole on the course. The fairway is narrow and slopes hard left to right. If the pin is on the back tier, hit to centre of green and hope to 2 putt.



Birdie opportunity here! Downwind Par 5. A drive down right hand side of fairway opens up green for second shot. Much easier hole if played in 3 shots rather than going for it in two.



Straightaway Par 4 with great view of hills. This hole begins at the green which has a large swale through it. Take extra club to get to back pin placement.



Fairway metal to middle of fairway. Although the look is menacing from the tee, the fairway is actually quite wide. Playing this hole without a penalty stroke is success.



Into the wind Par 3 with the largest green on the course. Club selection is key off the tee.



Par 4? Yikes! 3 shot hole for most when into the west wind. Fairway has generous width but is essential to hit if par is in your future.



Beautiful downwind par 3 with large tier in middle of green. Tee shot to correct tier can reward a two.



Stay focused from this short but tricky Par 5. Straight hitters will be rewarded with many pars or birdies. More slope on this green than generally read.



Welcome home! Great finishing Par 4 that requires a straight drive with a fairway metal. A short to middle iron will accommodate a second shot that once again must be a correct tier of green. Don't go long!
