

Point System

Points are awarded for both **Gross** and **Net** scores. Each club must have a minimum of 3 players to be eligible for any points. The low 3 Gross scores are used for the Team Gross total. All Net scores are used for the team net average. The Gross points are given to the top 3 teams (6-4-2). The team Net points are given for the top 3 teams (3-2-1).

Prizes

Each player on the Low Gross team is awarded a sleeve of balls. A sleeve of balls is also given to both individual Low gross and Low Net winner

Medicine Hat Junior Program Code of Conduct

Medicine Hat Golf & Country Club takes great pride in all of its members and its facilities. We ask that juniors follow this tradition and be proud of the club they belong to. In order to enable everyone to enjoy him or herself and to ensure that members know what is expected of them, this Code of Conduct was established. Golf is a game of honour in which respect for your fellow competitors and the rules are integral to the game.

This Code identifies the minimum standard the junior members are expected to meet as members of Medicine Hat Golf & Country Club, whether at the club or while representing it. The junior Committee believes that the Medicine Hat Golf & Country Club Juniors are capable of meeting these standards.

Junior, whether deserved or not, receive a lot of attention on the golf course. Therefore, we ask that they conduct themselves accordingly.

Attire

All clothing must be worn in a neat and respectable way. Shirts must be tucked in. We encourage juniors not to wear blue jeans, sweat pants and long baggie shorts. Cut offs or short shorts, tank tops, belly shirts or t-shirts (with offensive logos/language) is not acceptable. **Being dressed properly, allows people to treat you as an equal, no matter what age you are.**

Hats are to be worn properly. (peaks forward). We also ask that hats be removed in the Clubhouse. Use of headphones, Ipods or other electronics music equipment is restricted while on the course. Cell phones or messaging devices are to be kept on vibration mode when on the course and may only be used in the case of emergency.

Alcohol, Tobacco and Drugs

Use of these products is not permitted.

Golf Course and Club House Behaviour

Members are expected to act in a professional and courteous manner at all times, show respect to all individuals. Abusive or inappropriate language; throwing or breaking clubs; any form of cheating or abuse of the golf course in any way will not be tolerated. The golf club is an adult environment and you are expected to conduct yourself in an appropriate manner.

Behaviour at other Clubs

You are a guest when visiting other clubs and you represent yourself as well as Medicine Hat Golf & Country Club, the Code of Conduct applies when you are visiting other clubs. Thus it is important that you respect the values and standards of these other clubs and adhere to their policies should a stricter code exist.

Violation of the Code of Conduct.

If a violation occurs, the junior will be prohibited from further participation until he/she complies with the above code. The junior must do so without delay and then maintain the standard.

A Serious Code of Conduct violation will be referred to the General Manager and Discipline Committee. A meeting will be held to include the junior and their parents, a member of the junior committee and other individuals as appropriate. The meeting will be held at the earliest opportunity to investigate the matter and determine the appropriate response.

You are there as a competitor first and foremost, and secondly as a tourist. Players must observe rules as established by the Junior committee. Players must stay with the group at all times unless special permission is received from the chaperon (a buddy system). A disciplined athlete abides by the wishes of the authorized captains and staff.

You will be judged just as quickly by your general appearance as by your general behavior. Neatness and cleanliness do count! Know and follow the dress codes of the host clubs. Appropriately dispose of all garbage whether you are in your van, or on the course!

Bad manners and foul language rarely need a translator to be understood.

Any use of liquor or illegal drugs by any team member will not be tolerated, either during a tournament or in transit. Any violation **WILL** be dealt with immediately after it comes to the attention of Medicine Hat Golf & Country Club.

Any abuse of any of the above standards may result in disqualification from the team and early departure for home at the player's own expense.
